### His Story

Herbert was born in 1888 in Feckenham, Worcestershire to Walter, an omnibus driver and his wife Margaret Badger.

By 1891 the family were living in High Street Tarporley.

In 1901 aged 12 he was a butcher's errand boy but by 1911 he was living at Lutterworth at the house of James Darlington and working as a footman.

He married Mary J Cookson at Prestwich and died in November 1923 also at Prestwich.

Although he is recorded on the Church Roll of Honour there is no positive connection with Holmes Chapel.

### His War Record

In February 1918 he was reported a prisoner in the hands of the Germans and it was hoped to send him parcels.

There was no further news about Herbert.
