## **His Story**

Henry was born in 1877 at Arclid to Ambrose (a farmer) and Mary Broad. He was baptised at St John's Church, Sandbach on 6<sup>th</sup> May 1877.

By 1881 the family were living at Spark Lane, Smallwood, where Ambrose was running a 43 acre farm. By 1891 Ambrose was farming at Brick House, Congleton Road, Sandbach. Henry was now 14 years old and had a brother Hubert aged 7.

On the 22<sup>nd</sup> July 1900 Henry married Elizabeth Millington at Wheelock. The 1901 census shows him living in Back Lane, Congleton working as a farm labourer and aged 23.

By 1911 he was living in Middlewich Road, Church Hulme aged 33 and working as a coal carter. He had a son Hubert who was born in 1902 and four other children.

His death was registerd in 1963 at Crewe when he was aged 86

## **His War Record**

The Parish Magazine reports that he enlisted in 3rd Cheshire Regiment in November 1915.
