His Story

A William Brookes was born in 1887 at Faddiley near Nantwich. In 1891 he was at the same address and aged 4.

He continued working as an assistant cattleman when aged 14 and by 1911, aged 24, he was described as a farm worker.

On 8th October 1914 he was living at the house of William Thomas Pearson in Marsh Lane, aged 27, having recently married his daughter, Annie Pearson at St Mary and St Nicholas, Nantwich. His wedding registration has him as 'Brooks'
