His Story

Henry was born in 1891 to Robert and Sarah Ann Brown who lived at Hermitage Cottage, Goostrey Lane, Cranage. Robert was working as a cook/manservant at the time.

By 1901 Henry was 10 years old and living at the same address, now with three brothers and two sisters. One of his brothers, Alfred, also entered the war and died of wounds.

Henry died aged 86 in July 1977 in Shropshire where the family had moved some time before the start of WW1.

His War Record

The Parish Magazine records that Henry joined the Cavalry (10th Hussars) in October 1914.

In December 1914 he was shot through the thigh and was in hospital in Brighton.

There were no further reports.
