## **His Story**

Benjamin was born in 1891, the son of Joseph and Elizabeth. Joseph was a coachman. They lived initially at 72 Lime Walk, Headington, Oxfordshire, but moved to Brereton Green where they were recorded in the 1901 census.

By the time of the 1911 census Benjamin was living at Kermincham Lodge, Holmes Chapel aged 23, and was employed as a groom.

He married Sarah and had a son, Benjamin who was recorded as being christened on 9th Jan 1916.

## **His War Record**

He enlisted into the Cheshire Regiment in June 1916. In April 1917 he was in hospital at home due to sickness.

He was reported still in hospital in June 1917 but doing well

At the end of the war he was still in hospital, but the Absent Voters records of 1911 show he was a driver with the Army Service Corps (Motor Transport)
Nr.183028 and his home address at the time was Knutsford Road, Cranage.
