His Story

Frank Gerald was born May 1883 in the Salford District, son of James and Mary Haworth.

He is recorded in 1891 as living at Brentwood, Pendleton, aged 8 and at school. By 1901 he was a surgical plasterer's assistant and living at Moss Lane, Ashton on Mersey.

He subsequently came to Holmes Chapel and lived at Dane Bank, Cranage, home of James Bertram Haworth, his brother, who was a plaster manufacturer. Frank was also working as a plaster manufacturer and they had presumably set up business together.

His War Record

Little information is known about Frank's war record.

He joined late in the war and joined the Officer Training Corps in September 1918
