### His Story

Charles was born at Holmes Chapel in 1897 the son of William and Annie Henshall.

In the 1901 Census he was living with his parents at Macclesfield Road, Holmes Chapel, aged 4. In 1911 he is a school boy, aged 11 and living at Cherry Tree Cottages, London Road.

His death is recorded in Vale Royal District, May 1986 when he was aged 90.

### His War Record

Enlisted as a Private in the Cheshire Regiment, number 15342. He went to France on the 25th September 1915 and was discharged on the 30th July 1919.

According to the Parish Magazine he enlisted into the Army Ordnance Corps in November 1915.

In September 1918 he was in hospital with gas poisoning and was still in hospital in December 1918 but reported to be slowly improving.

He was awarded the Victory and British War Medals and the 1915 Star.
