His Story

Thomas was born at Cranage and baptised on 23/7/1899 at Church Hulme, son of Thomas and Nellie Elizabeth Hill.

His siblings, all born at Cranage were Nellie Cameron born about 1905, Enid born about 1907 and Norman Cameron born about 1910.

In the 1901 Census of Cranage, he was living with his parents, aged 1. In 1911 he was at school, aged 11.

His father, also Thomas, joined the army in October 1914.

His War Record

He enlisted on the 15th May 1918, aged 17 yrs 11 months and 5 feet 7¾ inches tall. His trade was given as teamsman.

He joined the 3rd Battalion of the Cheshire Regiment with the number 77048 and was posted to the Army Reserve on 10th October 1919.

The Parish Magazine records that he joined the forces and was included in the Roll of Honour in July 1918.

There were no further reports.
