His Story

Frank, son of Francis and Elizabeth Lee, was born in 1886 in Manchester, and it seems that his full name was Francis.

By 1901, aged 15, he was an apprentice engine fitter living at 5, Clyde Street, Chorlton, Manchester.

Job opportunities may have brought him to Holmes Chapel, and by 1911 he was a lighting electrician lodging with Mary Ann Townsend on Macclesfield Road near Saltersford Bridge.

Nothing is known of him after he joined the Reserves in 1915.

His War Record

The Parish Magazine reported in December 1915 that five men, one of whom was Frank, had enlisted in the Reserves.

No other records have been found, though his name appears on the Church Roll of Honour.
