His Story

Harold was born in Macclesfield in 1891 but we have no certain information of his family or location until 1911.

At that time the census return shows a Harold Mossey (sic) at Cranage aged 20, straw carter for Arthur Winstanley in Twemlow Lane.

His War Record

The Parish Magazine shows he was a member of the Cheshire Regiment in June 1915.

In January 1917 he was convalescing abroad but there is no indication of his problem.

In June 1918 he was reported missing and the following month found to be a prisoner in the hands of the Turks.

There was no further information.
