## **His Story**

Frank was born in February 1885 to Thomas (a railway labourer) and Isabelle.

By 1891 the census tells us that the family were living at Station Houses, Holmes Chapel and Frank was aged 6 and a scholar.

In 1901 the family were living in Macclesfield Road and both Frank (aged 16) and his brother Thomas were working as grooms.

By 1911 Frank was 26 and still single. He was living in at the Dairy Farm, Cranage as a waggoner.

Frank died on the 22<sup>nd</sup> July 1952 and was buried at Church Hulme aged 66. At the time he had been living in Macclesfield Road.

## **His War Record**

According to the Parish Magazine Frank joined the Army Service Corps in June 1915. There was no further information.

The Absent Voters List of 1919 gives his registered address as Macclesfield Road. His service number is 109230 and he is a driver for 333 Company, Army Service Corps.
