## **His War Record**

The Parish Magazine recorded that Fred Nixon joined the King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry in December 1914 and was serving abroad in September 1915.

There were no further reports.

The Absent Voters List of 1919 records his registered address as Knutsford Road, Cranage. He was a private Nr. 149058, serving in the 7th Battalion Machine Gun Corps.
