His Story

Frank was born in May 1898 in Sproston. His parents were David and Elizabeth.

Frank was one of six children and he grew up in Holmes Chapel, initially at Back Lane, and later at the cottage shown here by the station. Frank's father, David, worked as a railway signalman

In May 1922 he was married in Congleton District.

His War Record

Frank Joined the Manchester Regiment in December 1914.

He was reported in May 1917 to be seriously wounded and in hospital in Richmond.

In January 1918 he was discharged from the army on medical grounds after being in hospital for a long time but with the hope that he would soon be fit and well again.
