His Story

Samuel, son of Samuel and Margaret Stubbs, was born in Holmes Chapel in February 1886. He spent his early life at a home on Congleton Road and in 1901 was aged 15 and working as a coal agent.

By 1911 the family were living at Church View in the centre of the village, behind St Luke's Church. Samuel was 25 and working as a seed agent. His father, Samuel, was a coal and produce merchant's manager.

Two Samuel Stubbs were born in 1886 and died in Northwich Dist, the first in 1933 aged 46 and the second in 1957 aged 71. One married Grace Wood, in February 1919. We cannot be sure which Samuel is 'ours' on present evidence.

His War Record

There is no information in the Parish Magazines about his military career but he is listed on Church Roll of Honour.
