His Story

Stanley was born on the 22nd August 1894 in Church Hulme, the son of Horatio and Edith Tomlinson.

Horatio was a baker and Edith a teacher at a private school. In 1901 the family was living at Middlewich Road and Stanley was aged six.

In 1911 he and his family were living at Holt Cottage, Middlewich Road, and he was working as a clerk in a cotton spinning business aged 16.

Stanley died in May 1978 in Yorkshire aged 84.

His War Record

Stanley enlisted into the Royal Army Medical Corps in December 1915.

Nothing was then heard of him until September 1917 when he was reported to be in hospital.

In January 1918 he was laid up in hospital at home (England) suffering from trench fever. He was still in hospital in July 1918 when he was discharged from the army.
