His Story

Frank, son of Charles and Sarah Turner, was born in Pendleton, Salford in 1898. By the time he was three years old he had moved to 7 Shrewsbury Lane, Nantwich.

At 13 (in 1911) he was still at school and living at Hermitage Cottage, Cranage.

At the end of the war he was listed as an absent voter for a house in Hermitage Bank, Cranage, which may be the one in which he grew up.

His War Record

Frank enlisted as a private in the Army Ordnance Corps in November 1915. This was reported in the Parish Magazine and his name is included on the Roll of Honour, though there is no further information about his wartime service.

His two brothers Robert and Fred were also in the forces. Frank was still in the AOC and away from home in 1919 (Private 0011443).
