His Story

Alfred, son of James and Mary Woodcock, was born in August 1892 at Goostrey and was working there as a gamekeeper at the age of 18 in 1911, though in 1901 he had been living at Winterbottom in Brereton.

His father James Woodcock was the licensee of the Swan Inn in Holmes Chapel in 1915 when another brother, Richard, enlisted.

In 1916 Alfred married Margaret May Bateson

He died in February 1967 aged 74.

His War Record

All that is known so far is that Alfred enlisted in the 2nd Life Guards in December 1915, an event recorded in the Parish Magazine, and on the Roll of Honour.
